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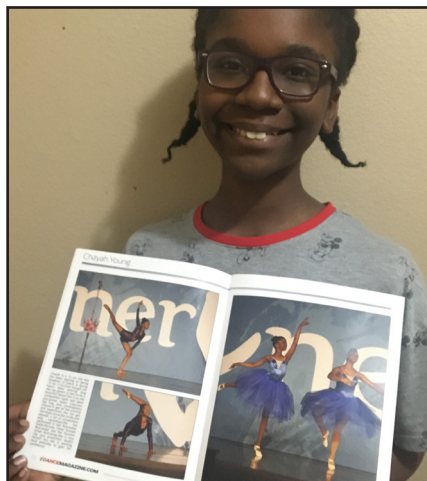

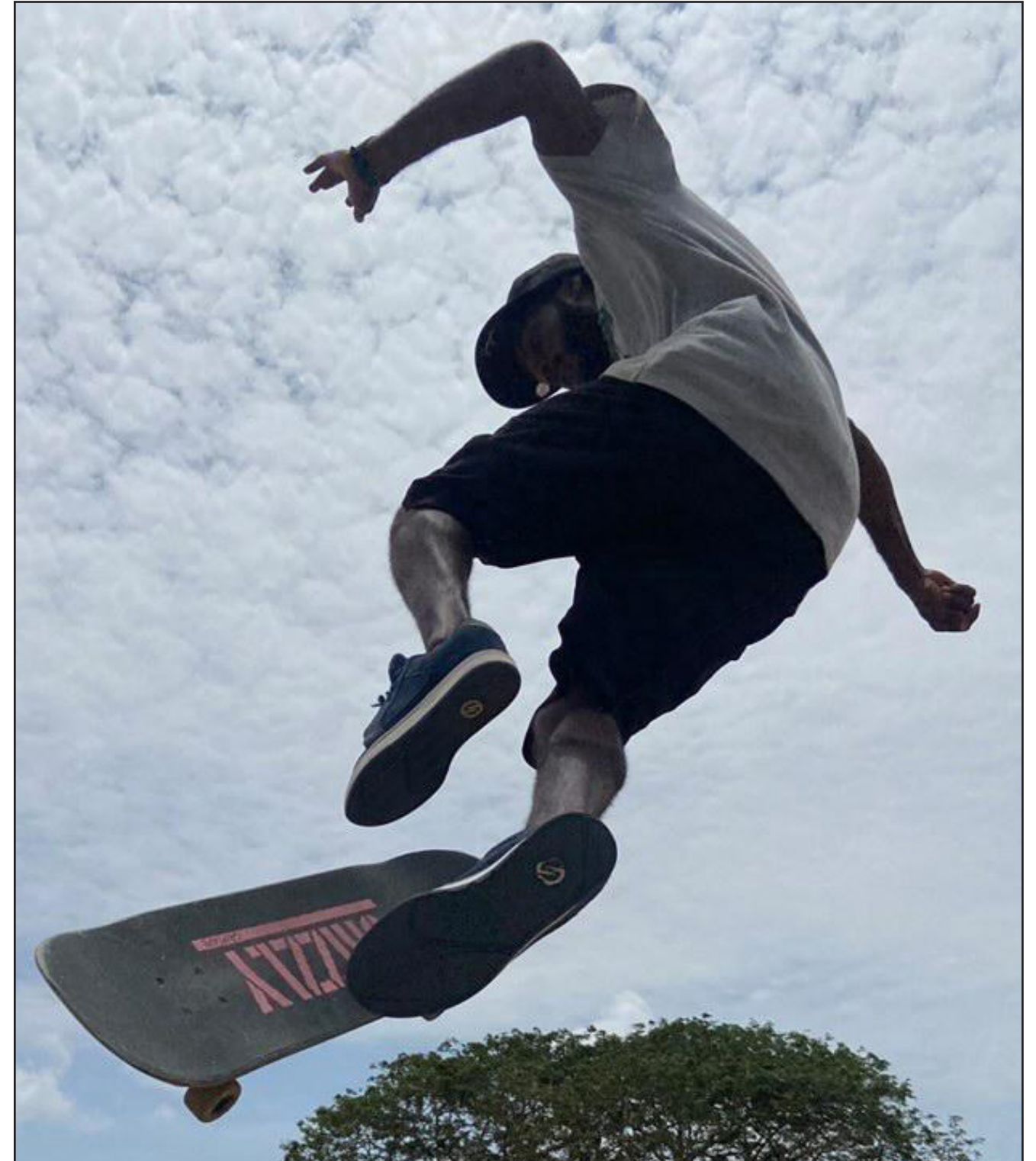
# Kane Connelly

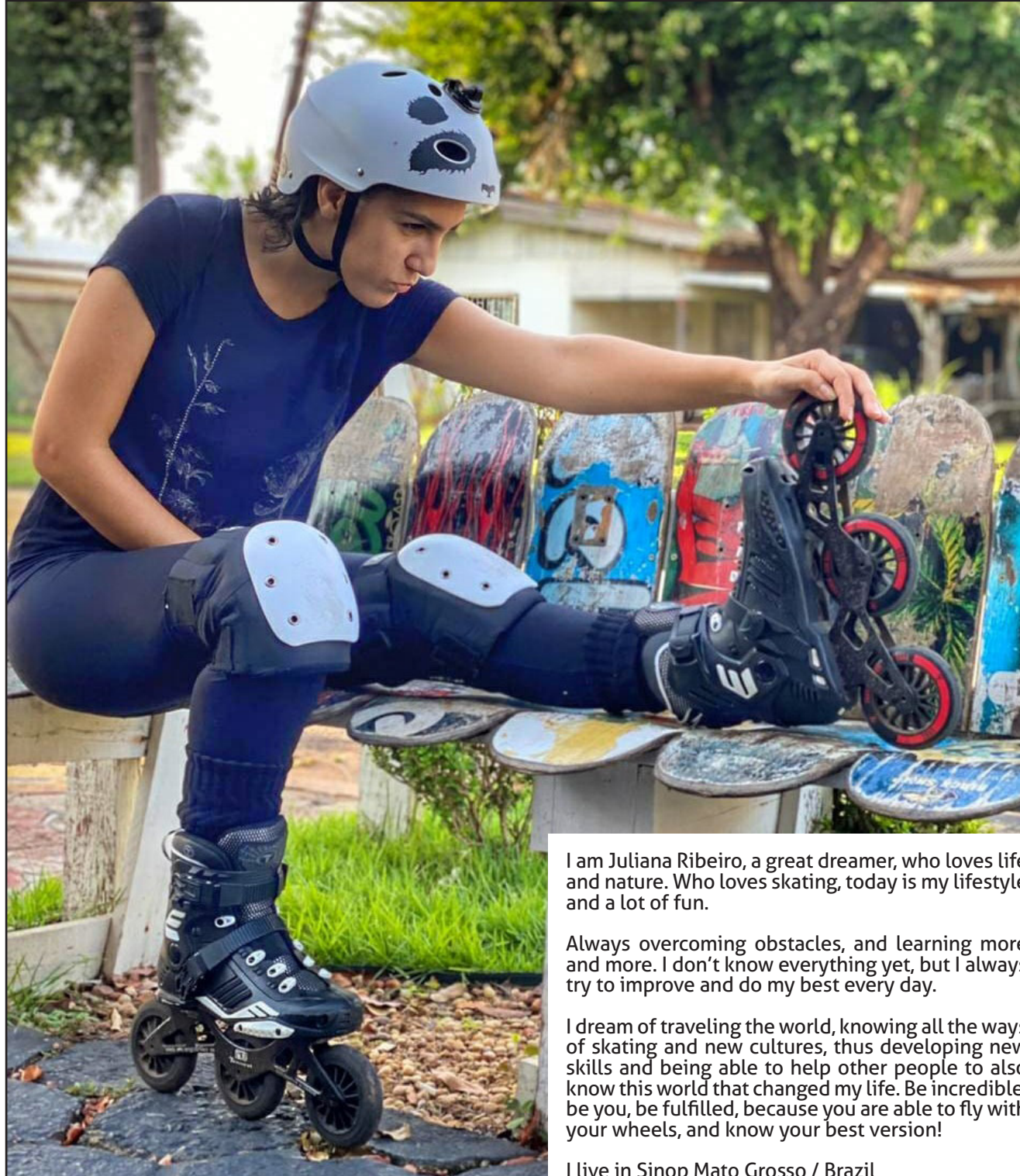
# Joshua Tetteh Odamtten

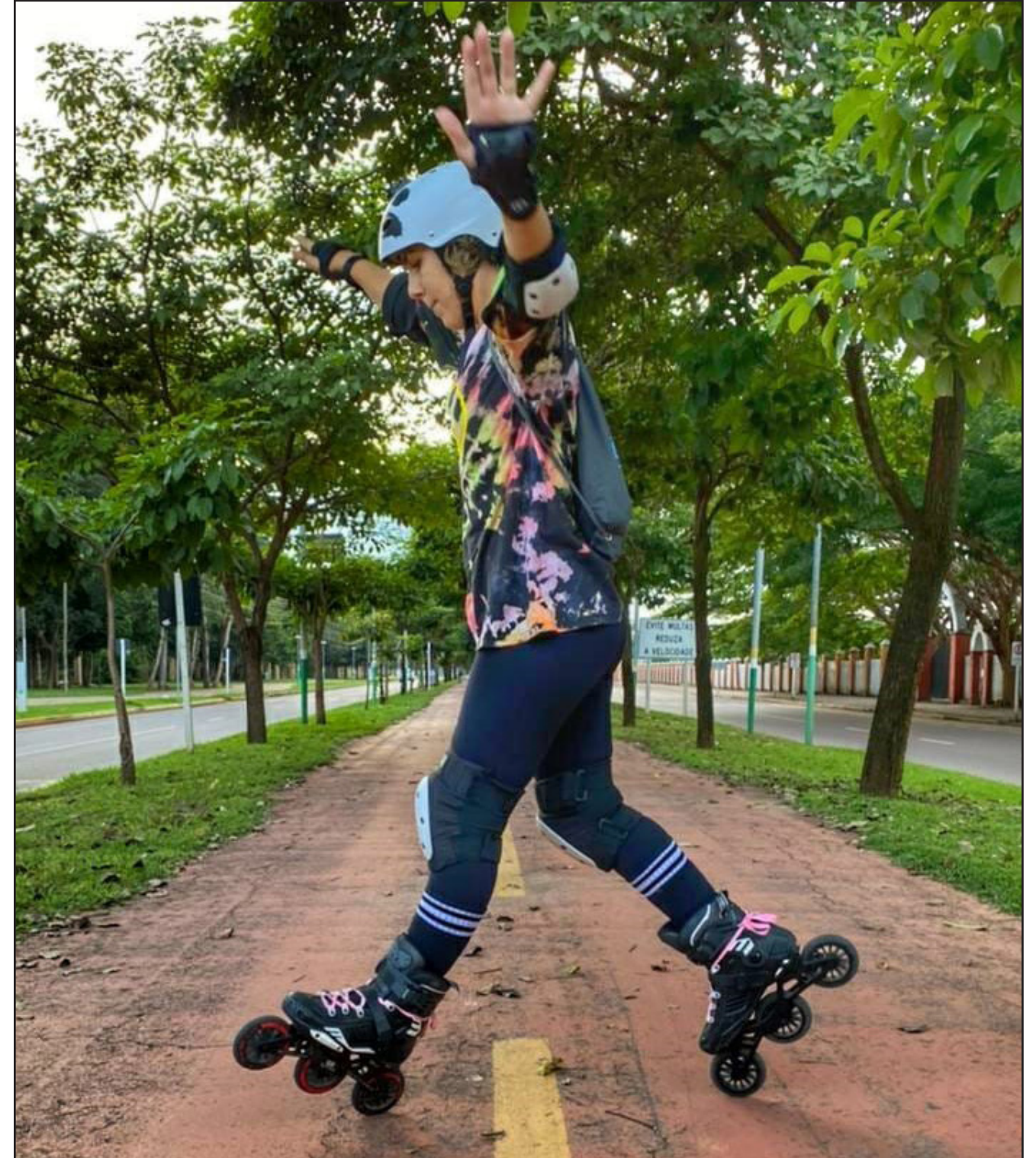


I am Juliana Ribeiro, a great dreamer, who loves life and nature. Who loves skating, today is my lifestyle and a lot of fun.

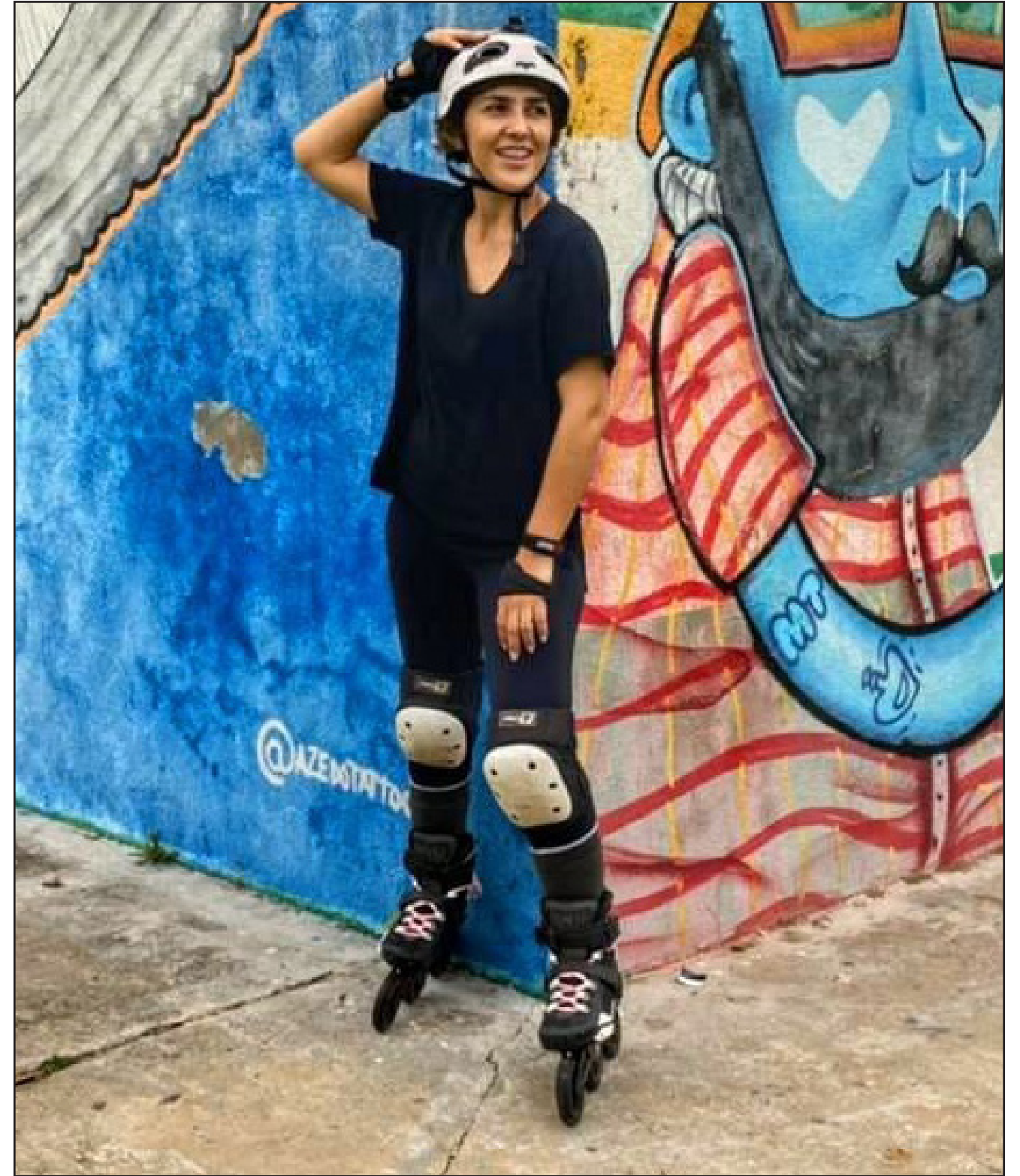
Always overcoming obstacles, and learning more and more. I don't know everything yet, but I always try to improve and do my best every day.

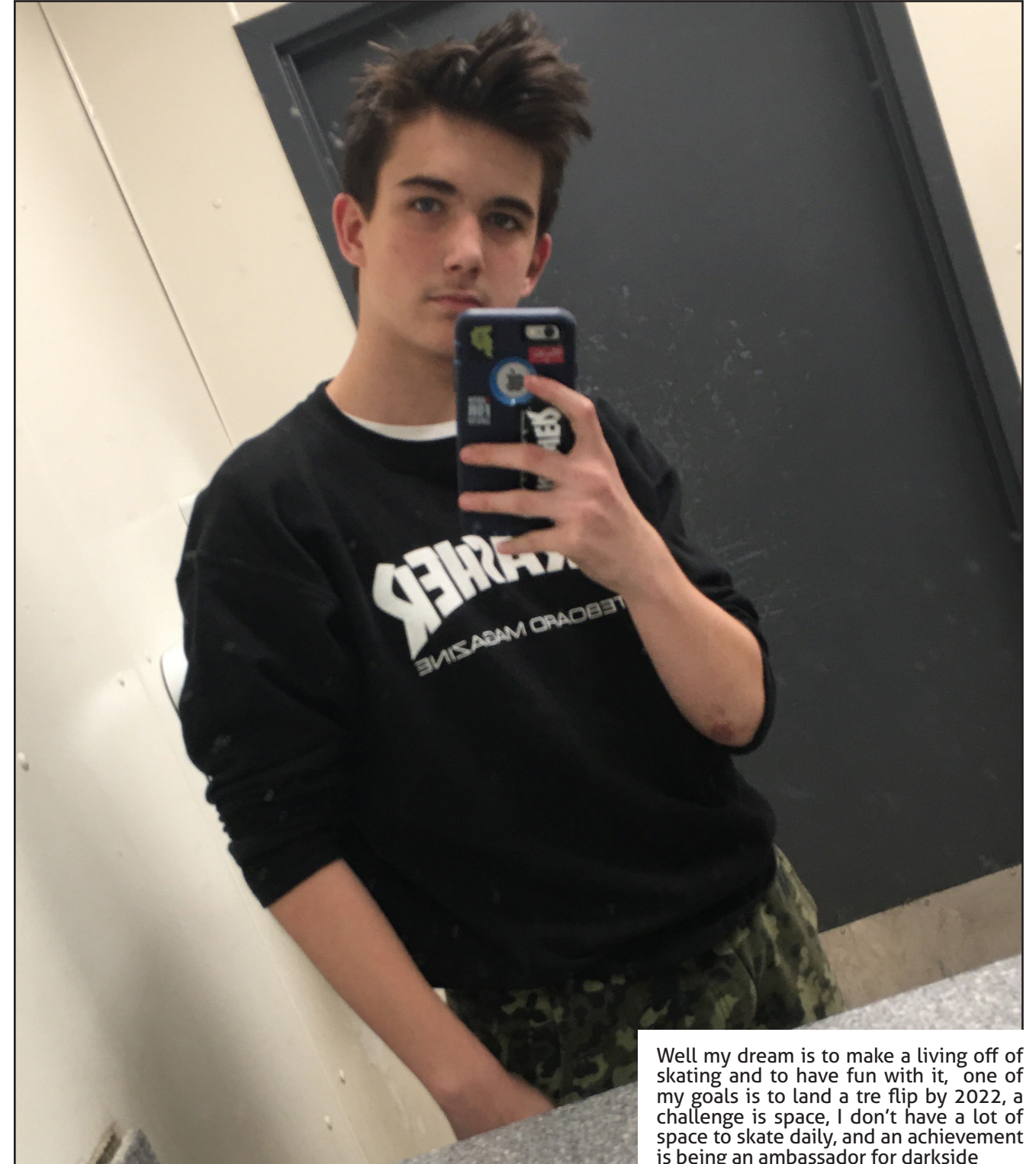

# Mack Adelsman



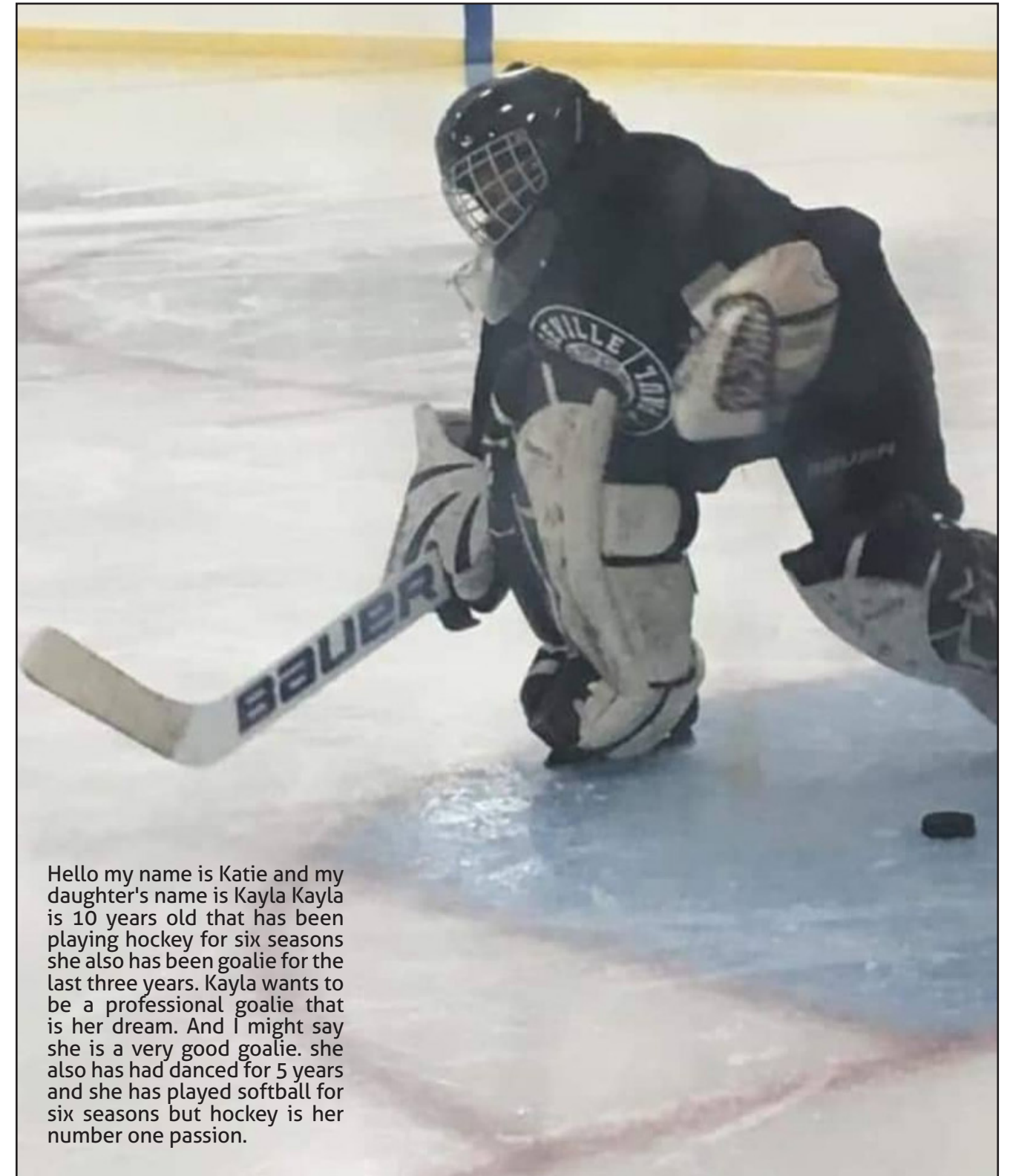

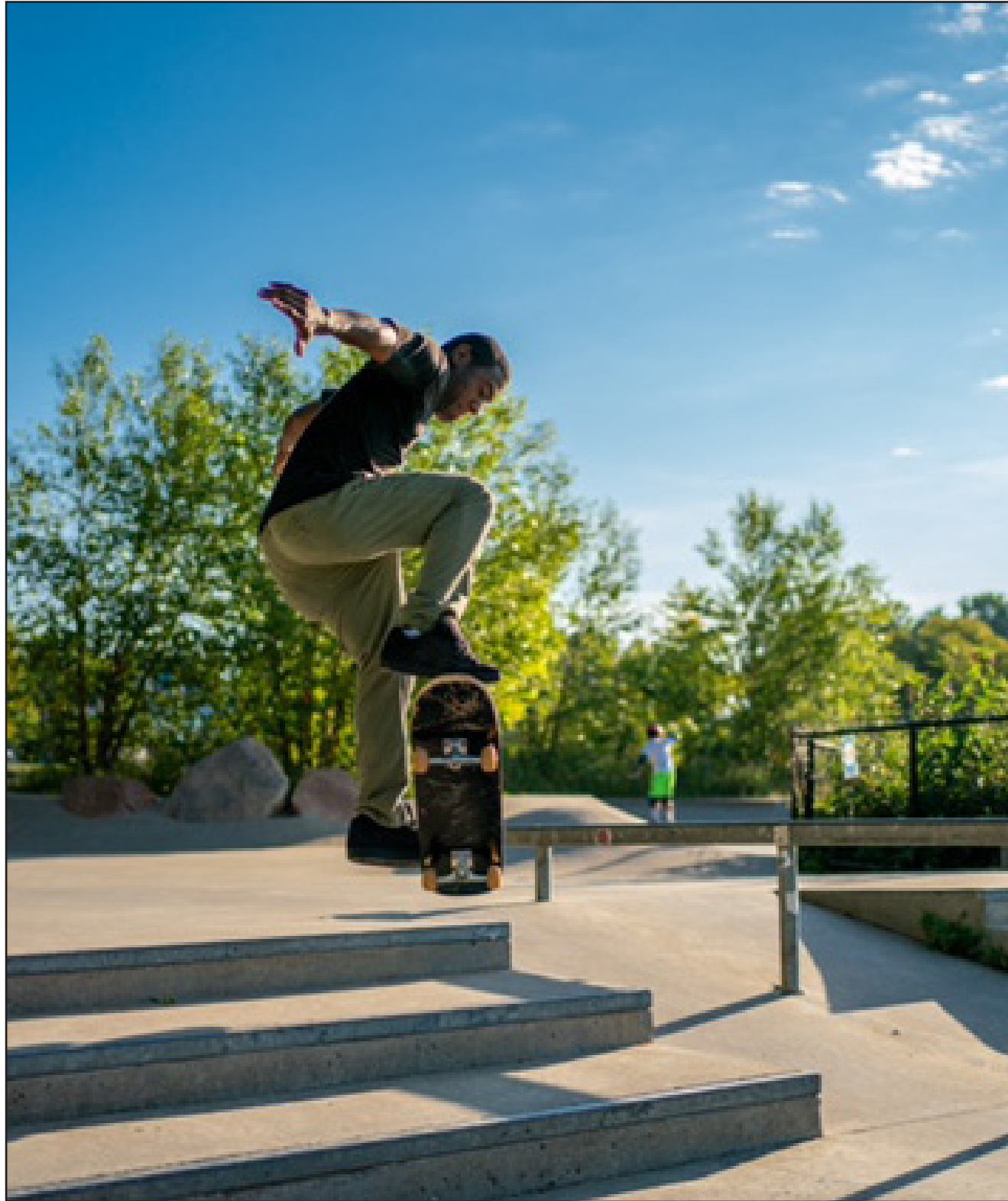


I have been skateboarding since I was 6 and I should have gone pro I'm interested in being apart of dc shoes and I love skateboarding. I skate mostly street.

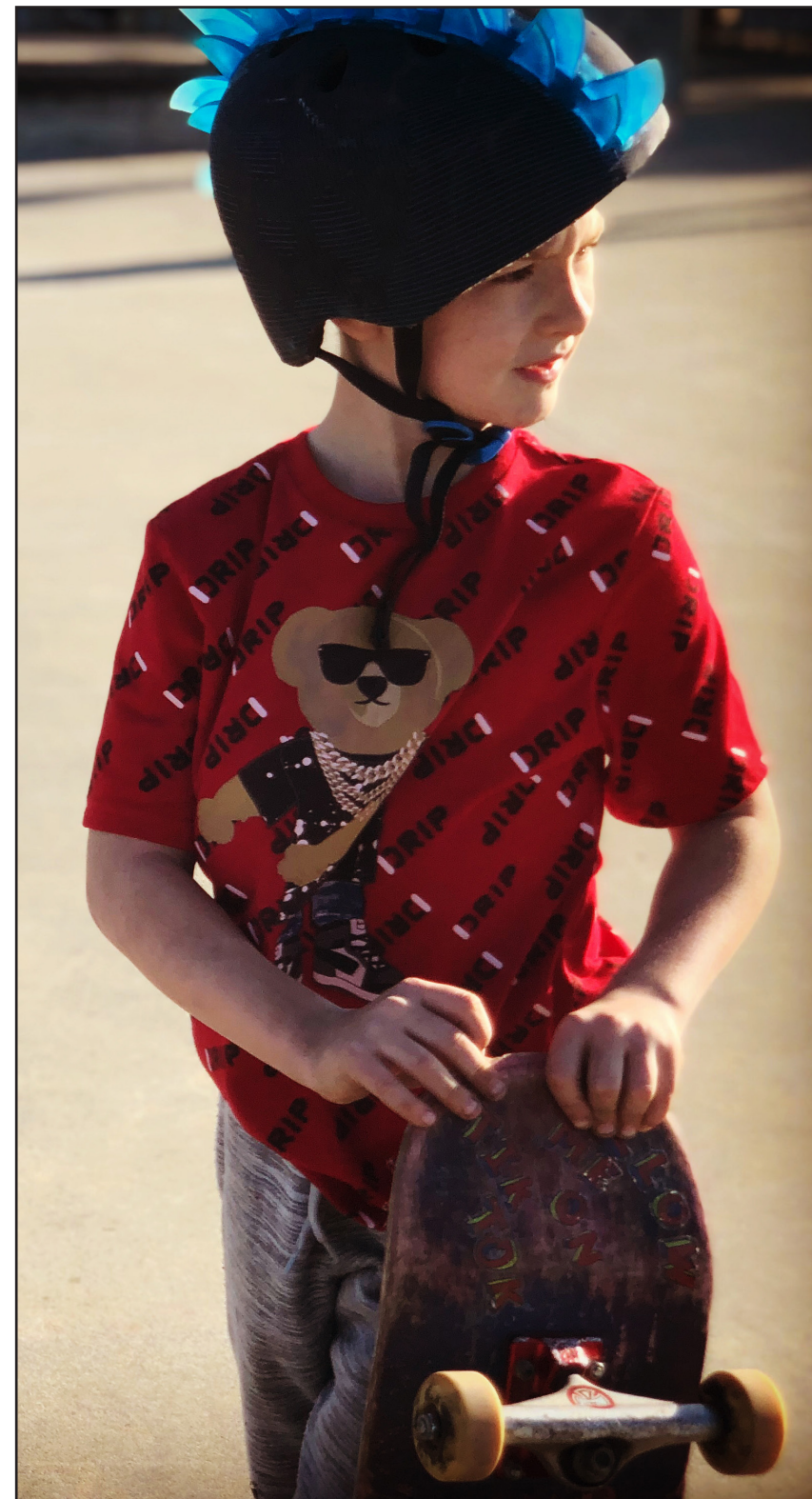
As I grew so did my love for skateboarding. On my fifth birthday my Mom and Dad took me to
